

Memorial High School ECHS Strategic Priorities

1. 85% of students will remain in the ECHS program through graduation.
 - a. The ECHS counselor will meet with each student at least 2 times a year to discuss high school and college advising.
 - b. Students who are struggling will receive additional advising from the ECHS counselor to include college mid-term updates.
 - c. Student grade tracker will be used to monitor students' college and high school grades.

2. 50% of students will meet TSIA criteria in mathematics and ELA/Reading (CCMR definition) by graduation.
 - a. We will identify teachers who have success with preparing students for TSIA and provide them resources needed to plan for TSIA intervention sessions.
 - b. TSIA prep sessions will be provided throughout the year, followed by testing sessions.

3. 60% of students will earn an associate degree by graduation.
 - a. Our campus team will collaborate with district and college staff to monitor students' caseloads to make sure they are on target for graduation.
 - b. Teachers will provide tutoring opportunities for students who are struggling.
 - c. Students will take advantage of courses offered in the summer to stay on track.
 - d. A student data tracker will be used to monitor students' college and high school grades, and course completion through the four years of the ECHS program.
 - e. Students will be enrolled in AVID classes, where students will be taught WICOR (Writing, Inquiry, Collaboration, Organization, and Reading) strategies to support the level of rigorous high school and college courses.
