

Memorial High School PTECH Strategic Priorities

1. 85% of students will remain in PTECH program through graduation.
 - a. PTECH counselor will meet with each student at least 2 times a year to discuss HS and counseling advising.
 - b. Students who are struggling will receive additional advising from PTECH counselor to include college mid-term updates.
 - c. Student grade tracker will be used to monitor students' college and high school grades.

2. 50% of students will meet TSIA criteria in mathematics and ELA/Reading (CCMR definition) by graduation.
 - a. We will identify teachers who have success with preparing students for TSI and provide them resources needed to plan for TSI intervention session.
 - b. TSI prep sessions will be provided throughout the year, followed by testing sessions.

3. 40% of students earn an associate degree or Level I or II certificate or associate degree by graduation.
 - a. Our campus team will collaborate with district staff and college staff to identify the appropriate Level I and II certificates offered through each PTECH program.
 - b. Teachers will provide prep opportunities for students prior to taking Level 1 and/or Level II certification exams.
 - c. A student data tracker will be used to monitor students' college and high school grades, and course completion through the four years of being in the PTECH program.
 - d. Students will be enrolled in AVID classes, where students will be taught WICOR strategies to support the level of rigorous courses in high school and college.
