What is Early College High School?

Early College High School (ECHS) allows students to receive a high school diploma and an associates degree, or up to two years of college credit. Students take a mixture of high school courses and college courses from Palo Alto College.

ECHS provides dual credit at no cost to students, offers rigorous instruction and accelerated courses, provides academic and social support services to helps students succeed, increases college readiness, and reduces barriers to college access.

ECHS students engage in advanced levelcourse work supported by a study skills curriculum. In addition to rigorous learning, students will receive lessons in social emotional skill sets such as self-management and communication skills. Students will also focus on TSI preparation to ensure that they are able to meet TSI requirements of the college coursework.
